### SUMMER 2011 CAMPS

*All camps are taught by professional artists/instructors.*

**June 13-July 1 Middle School/High School Musical Theatre Camp - "The Magical Land Of Oz"**  
/Ages 10-18 1-week camp, \$100; 2-week camp, \$170; 3-week camp \$240 /

**June 27-July 1 Elementary Musical Theatre Camp - "The Magical Land Of Oz" / Ages 5-12 \$110 /**  
Meeting Monday-Thursday 10a-3pm, these one, two or three week camps for middle and high school students will offer instruction in all aspects of producing a musical theatre production - including sets, costumes, music, choreography, backstage management and publicity. Elementary students participate in singing, acting and many other aspects of putting on a musical theatre production. All roles are cast from within the camp's participants, with all campers combining for a large-scale production to be performed on the Soo Theatre stage in front of a live audience. Performances are June 30<sup>th</sup> at 7pm & July 1<sup>st</sup> at 2pm.

**June 20-22 Set Design & Construction / Ages 12-Adult \$90 /** Three day camp, 10am-3pm. Camp participants will work with local artist Randy Krause to design and create set pieces for production.

**July 5-8 Toddler Camp / Ages 3-5 \$70 /** Four day camp, 9am-12pm. Students attend class for three hours each day, learning songs and movement. A short performance will be held on the Soo Theatre stage on the final day of camp.

**July 5-8 Drama Camp / Ages 10-18 \$75 /** Four day camp, 1pm-4pm. Students attend class for three hours each day to learn the basics of acting and theatre. Camp will end with a showcase performed on the Soo Theatre stage.

**July 11-15 Elementary Musical Theatre Camp - "A Little Bit of Showbiz" / Ages 5-12 \$110 /** One week camp, 10am-3pm. Students participate in singing, acting, and many other aspects of putting on a musical theatre production. The camp will culminate in a production of "A Little Bit of Showbiz" on the Soo Theatre stage. The performance will be July 15<sup>th</sup> at 2pm.

**August 1-5 Elementary Arts Exploration Camp / Ages 5-12 \$110 /** One week camp, 10am-3pm. Students explore the arts, including visual and performing arts, various instruments, as well as visiting interesting artistic and historic places of interest in Sault Ste. Marie. An exhibit/showcase of their work will be presented at the end of the week.

**Opera Program Workshops & Camps** – One, two or three week programs.

**August 1-4 - Studio Artist Workshop / \$175 /** Singers of all levels are encouraged to sign up for this one week vocal workshop focusing on all aspects of performance techniques for singing opera, musical theatre and art song. Classes will be held Monday-Thursday from 10am-3pm

**August 1 -12 "A la carte" Series: Master Classes and Individual Workshops** Individual sessions will be offered to students and/or the general public to provide an opportunity to study with our visiting professional guest artists. Pricing and session times will vary depending on individual package choices.

**August 1-21 Apprentice Artist Workshop / \$175 /** Participants will take part in the one week Studio Artist Workshop, attend the "A La Carte" Series and will be cast in the chorus or in supporting roles in the main stage opera "**The Marriage of Figaro**" August 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. Applications for apprentices are available at the main office. Singers may also send in their materials at any time to request an audition for Soo Opera Theatre productions.

**August 22-26 Dance Camp / Ages 7-Adult \$135 /** One week camp, 10am-4pm. Ballet experience required. Students will hone their skills and learn new dances from visiting professional dancers and dance masters. A dance show will be presented on the Soo Theatre stage at 7pm on Friday, August 26<sup>th</sup>. Select camp students may have an opportunity to perform with a Lansing-based dance company at Lake Superior State University's Arts Center on Saturday, August 27<sup>th</sup>. (A 10% discount on dance camp registration fees for all current STARS dance students is available.)
